**Mandarin Plus Summer Program** is divided into two terms of 4-week programs, starting from **June 27 – July 25, 2009** (first term) and **August 01 – August 29, 2009** (second term) to enrich participants with high quality Mandarin instruction, provide opportunities to practice with locals as well as facilitate networking and socializing with other participants coming from all over the world. Prospective students are welcome to apply either one or both of the available terms during this summer.

**Mandarin Plus Summer Program** is designed for participants from a beginner to intermediate Mandarin level to experience the best learning method of a language where it is spoken. Not only sessions in the classroom but also organized activities outdoor will demand you to practice and master the language thoroughly. Curriculum highlights on the accuracy of speaking and fluency as well as listening capability, grammar and structure, vocabulary and new words.

The program covers the following items:
